# "What is Sin? & Who Has Sinned?"

- ☐ 3 areas sin affects our life.
  - o Sin & salvation Our recognition of sin shows us our need or a Saviour.
    - <u>1 John 3:4</u> "Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law."
  - Sin & service Harms us physically & it limits our usability.
    - Galatians 3:24 "Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith."
  - O Sin & our relationships With our fellow man & with our Heavenly Father.
    - Man <u>1 Corinthians 3:3</u> "For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?"
    - God <u>Titus 2:14</u> "Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works."

  - o Recognizes his sin. vs. 3-6
  - o Recognizes his need for sanitizing from his sin. vs. 7-12

## I. What is Sin?

- A. Sin is not doing what you know you are supposed to do. <u>James 4:17</u> "Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin."
  - 1. Doing good for other people.
    - □ **Rom. 12:10** "Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another"
    - □ **Eph. 4:32** "And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you."
    - a. Being helpful
    - b. Being forgiving
    - c. Being considerate
  - 2. Obeying your parents. **Eph. 6:1** "Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right."
  - 3. Applying yourself in school.
    - a. <u>II Tim. 2:15a</u> "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed..."
    - b. <u>Hosea 4:6-7</u> "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children. [7] As

they were increased, so they sinned against me: therefore will I change their glory into shame.

- 4. Keeping your nose out of others' business and focusing on making sure you are doing what you are supposed to be doing. <u>I Thess. 4:11</u> "And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;"
- B. Sin is doing something that God has said is wrong. <u>I John 3:4</u> "Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law."
  - 1.Thou shalt not(s).
  - 2. Things that will hurt me or someone else.
  - 3. Things that will make God unhappy with me.
- C. Sin is something that will keep me from being close to God.
  - 1. Carnal mind **Rom. 8:7** "Because the carnal mind is enmity against God..."
    - ☐ Enmity = Condition of hostility; to be in opposition against; to fight against.
  - 2. Friendship with the world <u>James 4:4b</u> "...know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God."
  - 3. Not living by faith

☐ How can I overcome sin in my life? **Rom.6:16-23** 

- a. Rom. 14:23b "...for whatsoever is not of faith is sin."
- b. Heb 11:6a "But without faith it is impossible to please him..."

### II. Who has sinned?

- ☐ **1 John 1:8** "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us."
- A. Everyone was born a sinner. **Ps. 51:5** "Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me."
- B. Everyone has sinned. **Rom. 3:23** "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;"
- C. Jesus is the only One to walk this earth and never commit a single sin. <u>II Cor. 5:21</u> "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."

forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. [10] If we say that we have not sinned,
we make him a liar, and his word is not in us."
